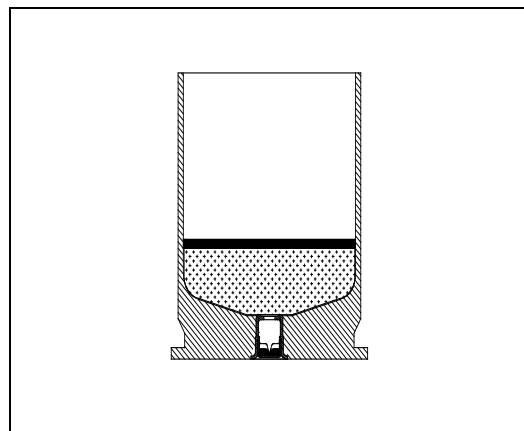

*The Model 3600 Launching Cartridge is very short, 2.0". Therefore, to prevent weapon malfunctions, each cartridge must be manually loaded into the chamber for each shot.

**Effective range is dependent on the launching cup, launcher, and weight of munitions being launched. The baseline for performance of a Model 3600 Launching Cartridge is that it will launch a Model 5230 CS Grenade a minimum of 87 yards (80M) from a LC5 Launching Cup on a Penn Arms Launcher.

CAUTION: To prevent damage to the weapon, when launching grenades, it is recommended to shoulder fire as opposed to putting the butt stock on the ground.
